The proposed service contract relates to a single-family residence being built on Assessor Parcel Number 0302-152-06, generally located on the northwest corner of Mill Creek Road and Julian Drive, within the City of Redlands' eastern sphere of influence, in the unincorporated Mentone community.

- Workshop Session: LAFCO 3282 – Countywide Service Review for Local Park and Recreation

A service review, as outlined in Government Code Section 56430, is a comprehensive review to inform LAFCO, local agencies, and the public about the provision of municipal services. LAFCO 3282 is the second-round service review for local park and recreation within San Bernardino County. The Workshop is for the Commission to provide input and direction to staff before issuing the draft service review to agencies for review and comment.

The Political Reform Act requires the disclosure of expenditures for political purposes related to a change of organization or reorganization proposal which has been submitted to the Commission, and contributions in support of or in opposition to such measures, shall be disclosed and reported to the same extent and subject to the same requirements as provided for local initiative measures presented to the electorate (Government Code Section 56700.1).
