

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION FOR SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Bernardino County ("LAFCO") intend to amend LAFCO's Conflict of Interest Code (the "Code") pursuant to Government Code Section 87306.

The Conflict of Interest Code provides for the disclosure of assets and income of designated employees, and the disqualification of those designated employees from acting where a conflict of interest exists. The Code specifically designates those employees, members, officers, and consultants who are subject to LAFCO's Code. LAFCO's proposed amendment revises disclosure categories, revises the titles of existing positions and update the language to reflect newly passed SB 852 revising form 700 filing requirements for Public Officials who manage public investments.

The proposed amended Code will be considered by the Commission on September 16, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Main Auditorium - Norton Regional Event Center, 1601 E. 3rd Street, San Bernardino, California. Any interested person may be present and comment at the public meeting or may submit written comments concerning the proposed amendment.
